Roehm America LLC continuously evaluates its products to determine if they contain chemicals listed under the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, known as Proposition 65. Whether there is a change to the Proposition 65 list of chemicals, or we change the raw materials in our products, we will update our customers about Proposition 65 listed chemicals in our products pursuant to the law or with guidance issued by the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment.

Roehm America LLC is a manufacturer of products selling to other businesses in a multi-layered supply chain (importers, packagers, distributors, suppliers, other manufacturers) for a product that may eventually be found in a retail setting in California. If a warning is required, we provide customers a warning notice and warning materials. Our customers and others in the supply chain must take actions appropriate under the law to ensure our warnings are passed along to any retailer and ultimately a retail customer (if that is the ultimate end use of a product).
