

State of Maine PFAS in Products Statement

ACRYLITE® and ACRIFIX® Products

Date: 1 January 2023

The Acrylic Products division of Roehm America LLC manufactures and distributes ACRYLITE® brand extruded and cast acrylic sheets, rods and tubes as well as ACRIFIX® acrylic cements and cleaners. The division is located in Sanford, Maine and distributes products for sale in Maine.

Maine Revised Statutes Title 38, §1614 requires manufacturers and importers of products distributed for sale in Maine with intentionally added PFAS to report the intentionally added presence of PFAS in those products to the Maine Department of Environmental Protection beginning January 1, 2023. Under the statute PFAS are broadly defined as substances that include any member of the class of fluorinated organic chemicals containing at least one fully fluorinated carbon atom. The Maine DEP interprets fully fluorinated to mean a carbon atom on which all the hydrogen substituents have been replaced by fluorine. However, the statute requires manufacturers to report the amount of intentionally added PFAS in their products by CAS number. Therefore, the Maine DEP interprets that PFAS subject to the reporting requirement of the law are limited to those that have a CAS number. More details are at:
